Hurricane Sally was the 18th named storm in the recordsetting season of 2020. Making landfall along the coast of Alabama, northwest Florida, specifically Escambia County borne the brunt of Sally's wrath. The storm generated a surge of close to six feet, making it the third-highest surge on record for the area. With tens of thousands of residents impacted across the region, and both a public and individual assistance declaration made by the federal government, the survivors of Sally are beginning the process of long-term recovery.
